It takes all kinds of people, in all kinds of rolls to help our congregation carry out our mission to reflect God’s generosity by serving and caring. Noisy Offerings

In honor of Veteran’s Day, and all who have served in the United States Military, our November Noisy Offering has been designated for Minnesota Assistance Council for Veterans (MACV). The goal of MACV is to end veteran homelessness in Minnesota. They do this in a variety of sustainable ways by providing housing services, employment services, and legal services.

Our December noisy offering has been designated for the LSS Youth Resource Center-Mankato. Formerly known as the REACH Outreach Center, this non-profit housed in Bethlehem Lutheran Church is operated by Lutheran Social Services and offers supportive services to youth ages 16 to 24 who are experiencing or facing the possibility of homelessness.

Noisy Offerings are intended to be given above and beyond regular offerings.

Collection Items

In November there are a variety of items you can donate to support local an international ministries:

- Diapers (size 4 and up) for Feeding Every Baby
- Body wash and soap for CADA House
- Operation Christmas Child shoe boxes are due by November 16.

Openers and closers will need to also unlock/lock the doors leading to the education wing every Sunday. Amy Ely will be trained in checking the AED in Pastor's absence.

**Treasurer's report -** Financial Statement review. See Treasurers report for additional details. Motion to approve: Amy Ely. Second: Marlyn Mosher. All in favor, motion carried.

**Bills to be paid –** Motion to approve with the transfer of \$1,211.00 from General to Building Fund: Korey Leiferman. Second: Amy Ely. All in favor, motion carried.

**Pre-School Report:** The Pre-School Committee is working on closing a few things out. They are recommending that the remaining checking account balance be dispersed to local charities, city programs etc. **Leave the CD as is until such time it is needed. Remaining funds recommended to be distributed as follows:** 10K to cover insurance deductibles, 10K to the endowment fund and to establish an early learning scholarship. Other funds to cover landlord expenses, property maintenance or active ministries.

**OLD BUSINESS –**

- The Abuse Prevention Plan has been reviewed and will be updated. Council members turned in or will turn in their signed agreement.
- The switch to Fidium is complete.

**Worship-** No meeting was held this month, but they are preparing for Confirmation on October 12th and All Saints Day on November 2nd.

**Fellowship** –Oktoberfest themed fellowship on October 5th . Annual Advent Holiday Potluck and Ornament exchange scheduled for Dec. 6th .

**Evangelism, Education and Outreach (EEO)** – September we will be collecting baby items for Global Health Ministries and on Oct. 5th will be packing these baby kits during fellowship.

We will also be collecting for Operation Christmas Child; boxes are due Nov. 16th . Reverse Advent Calendars will be distributed in December with food donations going to our Little Pantry. September noisy offering will be donated to Lutheran World Relief. October: Global Health, November: Military, December: Reach Center

**Property and Stewardship** -There are seal and masonry issues with the large stained-glass window in the Sanctuary, currently reaching out to St. Peter Glass who initially installed the window. They have a backlog of projects so they are not sure when they can look into it. A Mason will be contacted to check out the missing brick. There is a plug in that needs to be addressed. Trees along the driveway will be trimmed along with the tree limbs on the shed.
